An short excerpt to help you know what to expect: "GILLS OF ELASMOBRANCHS -

Most elasmobranchs possess 5 pairs of gill slits and a pair of spiracles, except that the primitive shark *Hexanchus* has 6 pairs and *Heptanchus* 7 pairs of gills plus the usual paired spiracles. Gill slits are lateral in sharks and dogfishes (*Pleurotremata*) and ventral in skates and rays (*Hypotremata*). There is no operculum covering the gill slits in cartilaginous fishes. In frilled shark (*Chlamydoselachus*) skin of each front gill slit covers the posterior gill opening. The anterior and posterior walls of the first four gill chambers carry pretrematic as well as post-trematic demibranchs, while the last gill chamber lacks post-trematic demibranch. A demibranch is a bunch of gill lamellae attached on one side of the interbranchial septum. Hence, there are altogether 9 pairs of demibranchs in elasmobranchs, of which 4 pairs are holobranchs (two demibranchs attached on the anterior and posterior sides of the gill chamber make a holobranch). Between the two demibranchs lies the interbranchial septum, which is supported by gill cartilages. Anterior to the first gill slit is a spiracle or pseudobranch."
